Reyna Martin said she received a call from Nye county Public Works and they wanted our 1,000 gallon, aboveground, diesel tank.

Jim Basinger stated no.

Reyna Martin said she had asked for clarification on whether they were going to take it, clean it and bring it back or just take it. She had not received an answer yet but they wanted to know the board's decision tomorrow.

Jim Basinger asked if Ray's station was going to be shut down.

Ray Dummar said no.

Jim Basinger said that was why he said no to the tank, because if that were going to happen, we would need that tank.

Reyna Martin replied that even if the station doesn't close now, there might come a time that we would need it.

Charles Gentry said he agreed and that we shouldn't let them take it. Even if there was a purpose, they might take it and never bring it back.

Jim Basinger stated that we've had a lot of things taken, and some are still sitting at the dump like our crane and truck.

Ray Dummar remarked that we paid a lot of money out and they didn't have anything in it because it was bought by the town and not the county.

Reyna Martin said there was a question on whether the tank belonged to the county or the town. She knew the tank had been here since we were a City so it belonged to the town.

Jim Basinger remembered when he was a volunteer working with Ray that there had been fuel in the tank.

Charles Gentry stated that if it were flushed out it would be fine.

Reyna Martin stated that Annette raised the question of liability on having the tank there.

Jim Basinger said if we put fuel in it, we might have to put in a containment wall.

Charles Gentry agreed that it would be easy to do.

Jim Basinger stated that after Donahue left we lost a welder, a tarper and a saw.

Charles Gentry remarked it didn't hurt anything for it to stay there.

Ray Dummar explained that his tanks had to be tested. When he finally found someone it would still be a while before they could come. He said Friday they came and put bags over them but gas still comes out the gas pump, we can't get any more until it's tested.

Reyna Martin said that the motor in number 3 well went down but Darrin was right on top of it and within days the motor was replaced, tests taken and passed and the well was back on line. She said the board was given the information on the race to Reno with the route for this year pictured on the back.
