

1 **NYE COUNTY RESOLUTION NO. 2017-66**

2 A RESOLUTION AMENDING AND ENACTING THE SCHEDULE OF FEES REQUIRED BY NYE  
3 COUNTY CODE TITLE 8, TITLED HEALTH AND SAFETY, CHAPTER 24, TITLED SOLID  
4 WASTE MANAGEMENT, SECTIONS 240: FEES FOR DISPOSAL OF SOLID WASTE AT  
5 FACILITIES, 440: APPLICATION, MONITORING AND LOAD FEES, AND 580: APPLICATION,  
6 MONITORING AND LOAD FEES

7 WHEREAS, on July 18, 2017 the Nye County Board of County Commissioners amended Title  
8 8, titled Health and Safety, Chapter 8.24, titled Solid Waste Management, which said Chapter places fee  
9 requirements to be adopted by Resolution, and

10 WHEREAS, fees shall be set by resolution;

11 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Nye County Board of County Commissioners  
12 as follows:


13 1. That the schedule of fees required by Nye County Code Title 8, Chapter 24 Sections 240:  
14 Fees for Disposal of Solid Waste at facilities, 440: Application, Monitoring and Load Fees, and 580:  
15 Application, Monitoring and Load Fees are hereby amended and shall be collected per the schedule of  
16 fees as shown in the attached Exhibit "A", which is incorporated herein by this reference.

**Title 8 Chapter 24 Section 440 Fee Schedule for Application, Monitoring and Loading Fees:**

- A. **Application Fee:** Each applicant for a hazardous waste permit shall pay an application fee sufficient to reimburse the county for all costs of processing the application, as follows:

Per application	\$1,500.00
Annual renewal fee	\$500.00

The application fee shall be in addition to any fees for expert evaluation, collected pursuant to section 8.24.420 of this article.

- B. **Monitoring Fee:** Each facility importing, receiving and/or disposing of hazardous waste in the county shall pay a monitoring fee sufficient to reimburse the county for all costs of monitoring that facility. The monitoring fee may be waived by the Board of County Commissioners if state regulation and monitoring is deemed sufficient to protect the public health, safety and welfare.
- C. **Load Fee:** Each person or entity holding a hazardous waste permit shall collect and remit to Nye County a fee for each load of hazardous waste imported to, received by and/or disposed of at the permittee's facility, as follows:

All Hazardous materials	\$1.10 per ton
All other wastes received	\$0.50 per ton

The facility importing, receiving and/or disposing of the hazardous wastes shall collect the load fee and, on a monthly basis, shall remit the same to the Nye County treasurer. Both of these fees schedules shall be adjusted annually per the CPI (with a 5% maximum cap).

- D. **Existing Facilities Waiver:** The Board of County Commissioners may waive all or a portion of the fees and/or application procedures provided for in this section for facilities in existence at the time this chapter is enacted. (Ord. 279 § 1, 2004)

**Title 8 Chapter 24 Section 580 Fee Schedule for Application, Monitoring and Loading Fees:**

1 Three (3) types of fees hereby are imposed upon private landfills, recycling facilities and other private  
2 disposal or storage facilities which import, receive and/or dispose of solid waste in Nye County, as  
3 follows:

4 A. Application Fee: Each applicant for a solid waste permit shall pay an application fee sufficient to  
5 reimburse the County for all costs of processing the application, as follows:

6 Per application	\$1,500.00
7 Annual renewal fee	\$500.00
8 Annual renewal fee, 9 Class 3 mining landfills	\$250.00

10 The application fee shall be in addition to any fees for expert evaluation, collected pursuant to  
11 Section 8.24.550 of this Article.

12 B. Monitoring Fee: Each private landfill, recycling facility, or other private disposal or storage facility  
13 for solid waste located in the County shall pay a monitoring fee sufficient to reimburse the County  
14 for all costs of monitoring that facility. The monitoring fee may be waived by the Board of County  
15 Commissioners, if State regulation and monitoring is deemed sufficient to protect the public health,  
16 safety and welfare.

17 C. Load Fee: Each person or entity holding a solid waste permit shall collect and remit to Nye County  
18 a fee for each load of solid waste imported to, received by and/or disposed of at the permittee's  
19 facility, as follows:

20 Hazardous materials	21 \$50.00 per truckload
------------------------	--------------------------

22 The facility importing, receiving and/or disposing of the solid wastes shall collect the load fee and,  
23 on a monthly basis, remit the same to the Nye County Treasurer.

24 D. Waiver: The Board of County Commissioners may waive all or a portion of the fees and/or  
25 application procedures provided for in this Section for facilities in existence at the time this Chapter  
is enacted. (Ord. 164, 1994)
